Headteacher Appointment



Summer Term Reading Challenge - Water Slide Fun Day!

The Summer Reading Challenge will begin on Friday 21st April and run for 12 weeks, finishing on Friday, 7th July.

Your child must read to someone at home **a minimum of 3 times per week (ideally 5) for 10 weeks** to achieve the challenge. This reading must be recorded in your child's reading record or homework folder and those children who read during all 12 weeks will get an additional reward.

The reading reward will take place in the week commencing 10th July and will be a return of the hugely popular water slide, hot dogs, choc ices, music & fun!
