Uniform reminder

Also, if your child has been out to play and has muddy shoes when they come to school please could you ensure they have a clean pair of shoes to change into. It is unfair to expect the cleaner to have to try to remove mud that has been trodden into the carpet. We will be asking children to leave muddy shoes in the cloakroom.
