Writing Teaching Sequence (KS1 & KS2)

Long Term Genre Map (fiction, non-fiction and poetry across classes over 2 year rolling programme)

Long-Term English Class Plan

(Identifies grammar in context for each unit – based on whole school **Grammar & Punctuation Progression** document)

Medium & Short-Term Unit Plans (Literacy Tree units, previous planning etc) — allocate units based on a high quality text into long term class plan

Teachers/Subjects/English/Literacy Tree – relevant class file (These plans can be edited, adapted to suit class needs or topic)

For year group expectations & progression refer to **Progression in Narrative/Non-Fiction** texts documents.

- Title Page (identifies writing outcome, audience, purpose, publication & grammar in context). Progression throughout school.
- Hook/Introduction of unit to capture interest
- RAFT reason, audience, features, tone (reference the writing process display in KS2)
- Immersion in text vocabulary development & identification of key features
- Explicit teaching of identified grammar (in context) with shared writing to model relevant features (display of modelled examples for children to refer to in KS1 & KS2).
- Planning (individual, paired or guided work) & choice to be given at least once in every unit, support, props etc
- Drafting independent writing (application of taught grammar following plan & use of Drafting Advice Sheet KS2)
- Editing & improving (within sequence and in final piece) CUPS (from Y2)
- Publishing/sharing to happen in every sequence (Author's Chair, assembly, display, class book, letters home/to a friend etc)
